Fee Increase From March 2024

As always Countryside Day Nursery offers high quality care and education for young children within the community, however, in order to continuously deliver these high standards there has to be a necessary fee increase. Considerations have been made to keep the fee increase to a minimum and the new pricing structure will come into effect from **Monday 4th March 2024**

I am writing this in December's newsletter to give you as much notice as possible. As you are all probably aware Countryside reinvests huge amounts of income back into the Nursery in order that your children can benefit from improvements and quality practice. Excellent variety of learning opportunities for your children to improve their outcomes and constant purchase of new resources are some examples of how your money is re-invested into the setting. In addition to this, I know that everyone is aware of the increase in fuel costs, food costs and general day to day running of a business. All of these factors lead to a necessary fee increase from March next year.

I have attached a new pricing structure with this newsletter. When children are accessing the universal 15 hours of Nursery Education Funding at the ages of 3 or 4 years, there is an optional food charge of £6-60p for lunch and £3.60 for both morning and afternoon snacks. Any unfunded hours at Countryside will be charged at £11-40p per hour. We accept the 15 hours funding 3 and 4 year old funding and parents are able to access a maximum of 6 hours per day on any one session, please note Countryside does not and is not planning to offer 15 or 30 hours of Nursery Education Funding for any other ages.

Please can I also take this opportunity to remind parents whose children are leaving for school in September 2024 to cancel their salary sacrifice childcare contracts, as Countryside Day Nursery cannot reimburse any payments which are made once the children have left the establishment.

Can I also remind parents to visit the governments childcare choices website which has a plethora of options to support parents with childcare costs.
