- Staff have high expectations of every child and provide an engaging curriculum for children to learn through play.
- Children are confident and self-motivated learners.
- Children learn how to be independent.
- Staff prepare children well for the transition to school and teach them important skills, such as how to follow instructions.
- Staff have a clear idea about what they want children to learn.
- Staff put swift interventions in place for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities.
- Staff enjoy working at the nursery and staff morale is high- they strive to constantly improve
- Staff model good manners and teach children how to follow the rules and expectations of the Nursery.

Daddies Morning

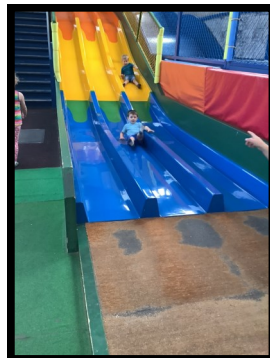
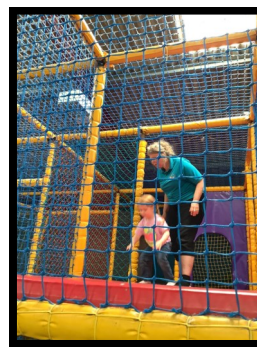

We will also be showing you, how we use the "ready for school learning programme" which is a great programme to support each child in Big Squirrels

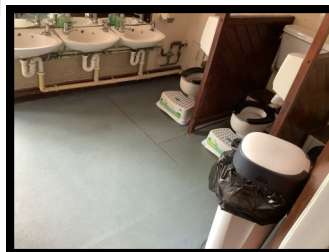

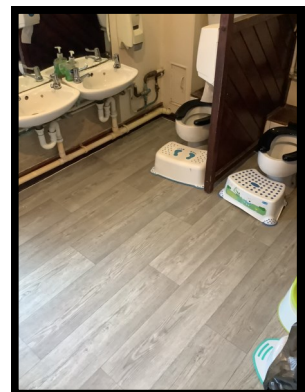
Little Squirrels Bathroom
