Parent First Aid

On Wednesday 10th April 2024 I have organised a free first aid refresher evening for parents. The session will begin at 6-30pm and we will aim to finish at around 7-30pm (depending on questions). The evening is an information evening where the trainer will be demonstrating the basics of first aid and how to save a child's life. This is not a certificated course, but if after the evening you would like to attend further training, I am sure that the company can signpost you to their training courses.



For me, I have organised this evening to raise awareness for anybody looking after young children. The first aid will be based on procedures for young babies and young children (not adults). We are also opening this session up to grandparents or any other relatives who look after your children. This would be an ideal session for people who would just not know what to do in case of an emergency but would feel more confident if they had the basics of first aid. Therefore, if you would like to attend, please could you email me and I will make sure I book the places for you.

Can I just remind parents to let me know if your child is attending another setting as well as Countryside Day Nursery. It is good practice that we liaise with the other settings, just to ensure that both settings see consistency in your children's learning.
