Therefore, we will be looking particularly at how effective the curriculum has been during this past year, alongside the levels of progress which the children have made. We will then be looking at how we can implement the curriculum successfully in Big Squirrels for the next cohort to ensure that we are meeting each child's needs as well as making sure we are giving them optimum learning opportunities here at Countryside.

Therefore, we will continue to analyze the results for the 2025 school leavers and put improvements into place to further develop our practice.

New Nutrition Guidelines for September



From September 2025 the DfE have published new nutrition guidelines for early years providers and childminders in England. As an Early Years setting we have been preparing for these new changes and we have had a meeting with Doreen and Kay (our wonderful cooks) to look carefully at the guidelines and our menus.

We currently have 5 weeks of menus and we have "tweaked" some of these in order to incorporate the new changes. Making changes to our menus at any time can be challenging as we need to trial different recipes to find out what is manageable within the oven space, we also need to offer foods which the kitchen staff can prepare and deliver, we also need to think about the vast array of special diets which we manage and finally and most importantly we need to provide something which we know the children will eat and not be hungry- otherwise we run the risk of then managing challenging behaviour and having unhappy children, which is definitely not what we want at Countryside. So, if you can bear with us, whilst we trial these menus and then we will send out our new menus from September.
